

# SUMMARY

## Objective

You have read the book A YOUNG WOMAN AFTER GOD'S OWN HEART by Elizabeth George. By now, you should have an understanding of how to pursue God's heart in your daily life. You have learned how to make prayer, servitude and joy your focus. You have been taught what the Bible says about interacting with your parents and siblings as well as choosing friends who are loyal and how to be a loyal, trust worthy friend. Your projects are to help you put what you learned into action.

## Goals

You are going to take what you have learned and apply it to a project of your choice. You get to show others the ideas of the book. You will complete a project to help instill that thinking in your life and spirit. Invite a few friends and make it fun.

## Choices

As a culminating activity you should choose one of the following activities to complete. These tasks are meant to be shared. Not only will you showcase your knowledge, you will spark an interest or change a heart.

YOU ROCK - Being A Young Woman After God's Own Heart means we should show His love daily. Here's what you'll need for this project: flat smooth rocks (palm size is perfect), multi-surface craft paint, paint pen and paint brush. Paint rocks (be creative!) and using a paint pen write a word, scripture or phrase of encouragement on each one. After they dry, hand them out to strangers or leave them in places where they will be found. Share this with your friends and encourage their involvement.

OR

“My Heart” Scripture Album - Gather the following supplies: Construction or Scrapbook paper, ribbon or yarn, hole punch, scissors, glitter, and other decorative items. Cut and decorate pieces of construction or scrapbook paper to be covers for your album. Take paper and cut pages for the album. Punch holes in them and tie together with ribbon/yarn. Using personal photos and/or magazine clippings (pictures, phrases, words and letters) create an album of reminders of how you can live the life of a Young Woman After God’s Own Heart.

Whichever one you choose, have fun with it. Share what you learned with someone. Write a paragraph for the Girls Ministries website and include photos of your work. We would love to see the creative ideas you come up with. Remember to live life with a heart completely devoted to God. With His guidance you can make wise choices, have meaningful relationships and an amazing future!
